The Blue Grotto - Zurrieq



The Blue Grotto is situated on the south coast of the island of Malta. This natural picturesque grotto and its neighbouring system of caverns is famous for the clarity of water and brilliant colours around the rocks in the caves that mirror the brilliant phosphorescent colours of the underwater flora. The best way to see the Blue Grotto and surrounding coastline is to take a trip on a 'daghjsa', a traditional Maltese fishing boat. The clear blue-green water and wild rocky landscape have made the 'valley' a popular haunt for swimming and sunbathing. Back in the 70's a Cadbury's Milk Tray advert was shot at the Blue Grotto and in 2004 the venue was also used for a scene in the film Troy starring Brad Pitt.
