Christmas and New Year Celebrations in Malta



Christmas is a highly celebrated festivity in Malta and Gozo, both as a popular event for people of all ages, as well as an important date on the religious calendar. The season is celebrated to its full on the Islands; nativity scenes, displays of cribs (from private houses to small chapels), carol services and other events are organised in each locality. A Christmas highlight, which is popular for children and adults alike, is the annual pantomime held at the Manoel Theatre. The Christmas Season is also a time for parties, shopping, outdoor celebrations and family get-togethers which end in a traditional countdown to the New Year on December 31st.

The only days when the school will be closed (i.e. no lessons will be held) will be Friday 25 December 2009 - Christmas Day and Friday 1 January 2010 - New Year's Day (both these days are Public Holidays in Malta).

The sound and light effects impart a feeling of awe, and an impression of interaction with the figures on display. Some graphic scenes of torture are not suitable for young children.
