Word of the Month - google or Google



google or Google verb [I/T] - to use the Internet search engine Google™ to find information about someone or something
Googling noun [U]
Googler noun [C]

Google™ is arguably one of the most effective and powerful search engines on the Internet, if people want to find something online, they invariably take a look at Google™ search results, so it is no surprise that the name of this tool has become synonymous with the idea of the activity of searching the Net.

google as a transitive verb lies predominantly in the context of finding out information about people, as the quote above illustrates. Passive use is very common here, individuals under scrutiny are, or very commonly get, googled. This has led to use as a participial adjective Googled, e.g. the Googled party.

The uncountable noun Googling is regularly used as a description of the activity, and Googlers are those who engage in it. The term is becoming so established that there is evidence for its use as a general reference to using any search engine on the Web, not necessarily Google™ itself.
